

Mozilla Firefox Setting for Viewing Assessment Overview and other Reports When Not Appearing Full Screen

1. Run the **Assessment Overview Report** (see the *CSA Manual* or *CSI Manual* for instructions on running this report)
2. **Right-click (#1)** in the frame and choose **This Frame (#2)**, **Open Frame in New Tab (#3)**
