## PROJECTS AND UNIQUE ATTRIBUTES<sup>5</sup>

Great Plains Business Center (Incubator) is scheduled to open in late autumn of 2016. The 23,000 square-foot facility will focus on entrepreneurs who are engaged in light manufacturing, commercial food production or the commercial arts.

Great Plains newly remodeled state-of-the-art Testing Center administers more than 4,000 tests each year (3,500 to students and 500 to community businesses and stakeholders.) GPTC's Testing Center expects to become an official Pro Metric Test Center in mid-2016.

Great Plains' has expanded its renowned *Project Lead the Way Pre-Engineering program* to all three Lawton high schools. GPTC instructors teach the PE classes. More than 200 students are enrolled in pre-engineering either at the Great Plains Lawton campus or at one of the Lawton schools.

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
