Facts:

- Established in 1946
- Named For US Senator Mike Monroney, "Mr. Aviation"
- Largest FAA Field Facility in the Country
- Occupies over 1000 acres
- Personnel - Over 7,000 Federal Employees, Contractors & Students
- Another 20,000 Students Come Through the Center Each Year
- Budget at Approximately One Billion Dollars Per Year
- Several Major Organizations Operate in a Franchise Fund

- Establishes FAA AMS Small Business Guidance and Policy. Exempt from FAR.
- Monitors and Evaluates the effectiveness of the small business program to ensure that objectives and goals are implemented and accomplished.
- Hosts and participates in Small Business Outreach events and activities.
