This activity will help students to describe work-related activities necessary in the school.

MATERIALS/SUPPLIES

Marker board, large sheets of butcher paper or chart paper, colored markers/pens

ACTIVITY

- Invite the following school personnel to class:

Secretary

Food manager

Principal

Custodian

Nurse

Counselor

Teacher

Write each occupation on a large sheet of paper or marker board.

Ask each to talk to the students about their jobs (what job do they have, why do we need them, what tools or equipment do they use).

Have a discussion about each job.

Visually depict the interdependency between various jobs by connecting jobs to each other with colored lines.

Have the students make the suggested connections and explain their connections.

NOTE: This activity may be extended over several days.

EXTENSION

- Have the class write a short story about each person.

EVALUATION

Students will be evaluated on their attentiveness and participation in the discussions.
