Definitions for OK Career Guide training

Galaxy - This training is for participants who wish to implement career exploration into pre-kindergarten through fifth grade. This will provide participants with the knowledge of the program with age appropriate teaching strategies. The training will also cover the admin side and show how to upload students along with what information can be pulled from the system. Finally, the training will look at how to roll students over from year to year.

Beginner - This training is for participants who have never attended OK Career Guide training. This will provide you with the foundational knowledge to use with students in sixth through 12th grades. We will provide a broad overview of other components of OK Career Guide, but, the primary focus will be on becoming familiar and comfortable with the student/user platform of [OK Career Guide](#).

Advanced & ICAP Components - This training is for participants who have previously attended OK Career Guide training and are looking for a great time to learn about My Ed Plans (seventh grade to two years postsecondary planning tool), E-Portfolio (personalized URL for users to highlight career development and qualifications) and C2B (Connect to Business, where schools can open up OK Career Guide related opportunities to students wishing to gain work-based learning experience). This training will not provide a walk-through or creation of an OK Career Guide account. Please come to training with your user names and passwords and be ready to dig into a deeper implementation of the system and career development outreach for your school.

Admin and ICAP Implementation - This training is for participants who have previously attended OK Career Guide training and are looking for a great time to gain knowledge from other schools' promising practices, implementation and strategic schoolwide career development planning. ADMS is the school data platform providing educators and communities with information about their students' interests and usage, which can be used in making ICAP strategic plans for district implementation. This training will not provide a walk-through or creation of an OK Career Guide account.
