



EoC assessments are online exams given at the end of PLTW high school courses¹. EoCs serve as an indicator of a student's overall achievement in the course.

PLTW's assessment and curriculum experts collaborate with PLTW pilot teachers and use industry best practices to develop and test EoC assessments.

PLTW validates new EoCs through a multi-year process to ensure the accuracy of the assessments, and they are continuously updated to ensure validity and reliability.

Timely, Valid Assessment Results

PLTW teachers and administrative leaders get access to EoC scores within 24 hours of EoC completion.

PLTW reports valid and reliable scores on overall student performance within the course, which gives PLTW students in grades 9-12 an evaluation of their achievement and provides teachers and administrators with the information they need to make informed decisions.
