CHAPTER AFFILIATION GUIDE 2018-2019

Why **BUSINESS PROFESSIONALS OF AMERICA?**

Business Professionals of America is the leading CTSO (Career and Technical Student Organization) for students pursuing careers in business management, office administration, information technology and other related career fields.

BPA has 43,000 members in over 2,300 chapters in 23 states. BPA is a co-curricular organization that supports business and information technology educators by offering co-curricular experiences based on national standards.

BPA's Chapter Affiliation/Curriculum Program is designed to be simple, easy, cost-effective and value-filled so that educators can utilize BPA tools in the classroom and campus setting to positively impact Career and Technical programs and students!

All currently active and brand new Oklahoma BPA chapters must meet the following requirements regarding Career and Technical Education, mandated by the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education:

1. Be an approved organization on campus with a certificated faculty member serving as your chapter advisor.
2. The advisor must have a CTE teaching certificate in one of the following approved areas (exceptions may apply for home school chapters): Business Education, Marketing Education, or Career and Technology Education, unless home schooled or special provisions are granted through the state charter holder.
3. All students participating in Oklahoma BPA must have taken or be currently enrolled in one of the following Career and Technical Education (CTE) classes in 2018-2019: Marketing, Business Management and Administration, Finance, or Information Technology, unless home schooled or special provisions are granted through the state charter holder.

The Oklahoma BPA School Affiliation/Curriculum Pricing Guide is as follows:

Annual affiliation fees for the BPA calendar year (July 1 – June 30)

1-20 students \$400.00

If more than 20 students are participating in the affiliation/curriculum program, you will pay an additional \$20 per student affiliated. All mid-level and secondary, high school chapters of Oklahoma BPA will be required to pay the School Affiliation/Curriculum Program Fee.

The School Affiliation/Curriculum Program Fee will be paid directly to Business Professionals of America.

Once a chapter submits their Affiliation/Curriculum Program fee they become an official Oklahoma BPA Local Chapter. Official Local Chapters gain access to the following curriculum, resources, programs, and college and career development experiences.

BPA on Campus!

The Affiliation/Curriculum Program fee provides a School Site License for students and teachers to operate a local BPA chapter and be affiliated with Oklahoma BPA and National BPA.

Workplace Skills Assessment Program

BPA Competitive Events feature over 70 competitive events spanning the fields of entrepreneurship, marketing, finance, hospitality, and management. *(Additional fees apply for conference attendance)*

The Workplace Skills Assessment Program (WSAP) prepares students to succeed and assesses real-world business skills and problem solving abilities in business management and administration, finance, marketing sales and service, and information technology. It is BPA's showcase program and facilitates students demonstrating their career skills at regional, state and national conferences in 72 competitive events.

Some of BPA's other major programs include the National Leadership Academy, Officer Elections and scholarships. The Torch Awards Program and BPA Cares Program recognize students and chapters, respectively, for their leadership and service to their chapter and community.

Exclusive to BPA School Affiliate/Certification Program

Members have the opportunity to complete any or all of the introductory life skills webinars from those listed below. With successful completion of a minimum of six (6) courses, members can earn a Digital Certification Badge which can be displayed in their digital portfolio and on various social media platforms and applications.



In the BPA Life Skills Achievement, each course is:

- Short (less than 30 minutes to complete)
- Mobile (desktop/laptop, phone or tablet).
- Full of information (expert advice, quality content, videos, and a quiz).
- Upon completion, learners will receive an electronic badge specifically designed for Business Professionals of America members to tout their accomplishment.
- This badge can be placed on résumés, shared on social media, sent to employers/potential employers, and more.

BPA chapters are eligible to participate in annual BPA Conferences including, but not limited to:

- BPA National Leadership Conference
- Oklahoma BPA State Leadership Conference
- Oklahoma BPA Fall Leadership Conference

Why the CHANGE?

This new affiliation model was created to strengthen BPA's co-curricular integration model and reach more students. BPA has traditionally been a membership driven educational tool. In this model, BPA was too often treated on campus as a school club or extra-curricular organization. However, the richness of the BPA educational experience is at its fullest strength and provides the greatest educational value when BPA is operated as a co-curricular instructional tool. The new site license model for BPA affiliation is aimed at giving teacher advisors an easier and more inclusive format for integrating BPA on campus and in CTE classes.

Q: What about professional membership for advisors?

A: Advisors are included in the BPA Affiliation/Curriculum Program site license. If they have 1 advisor, they can have 19 students, if they have 2 advisors, they can have 18 students, and so on.

Q: What about Professional and Alumni membership?

A: Professional and Alumni membership is not included in the BPA site license model.

Q: What about a new chapter that will only have a handful of BPA students in their first year?

A: All BPA Chapters are required to maintain/serve at least 10 students annually. Oklahoma has always set the bar for rigor in Career and Technology Education. Historically, 50% of Oklahoma's local chapters have maintained at least 20 students benefitting from BPA's Affiliation and Curriculum Model.

Q: Once I've registered students in the BPA affiliation system can I make changes?

A: Once students are registered in the national BPA system and the roster is submitted to BPA no changes can be made (e.g. no drops, no substitutions, etc.). You can continue to add students, but no other changes are allowed.

Q: What if I want to add students later in the year?

A: You can continue to add students to your roster throughout the year. Note that to be eligible for competition students must be in the system and submitted to BPA prior to the registration deadline for the conference they plan to compete in. We hope you will utilize this opportunity as a way to grow your local chapter.

Q: Is there any benefit to having more/less students?

A: Once you have paid your annual Affiliation and Curriculum Program Fee, you are encouraged to register as many students as you can. To get the most out of your BPA affiliation payment (e.g. you will want to maximize your benefit by using all 20 versus just having 10 or 15). The price is the same within the Oklahoma Affiliation and Curriculum Program Fee regardless of the number of students/advisors you have registered.

Q: How do we register our chapter with BPA?

A: Schools will use the same BPA system they have used in the past to register their students, advisors, professionals and alumni. It will continue to be done online through the BPA website that was used before: (<http://www.registermychapter.com/bpamem>)

POTENTIAL SOURCES OF FUNDS TO COVER THE BPA AFFILIATION/CURRICULUM PROGRAM SITE LICENSE

One of the benefits of the new BPA Affiliation/Curriculum Program model is that it opens up a variety of options for chapters to acquire, earn or receive funds to cover their site license payment. The list below is a starting point for potential sources of funding and not intended to be an exhaustive catalog of options. Chapters are encouraged to seek out all possible options for funding through their network.

Donors/Partners/Sponsors

Chapters can now look at a sponsorship model whereby groups/individuals could “sponsor” the local BPA chapter by providing the funds to cover the chapter’s affiliation site license for the number of students they intend to enroll in BPA.

School/District Budgets

Many school districts have funds/accounts available that can be used to cover educational resources like educational subscriptions and site licenses. Connect with administrators and school/district personnel who specialize in CTE to see what funds might be available or how to have BPA considered for future budget cycles.

Curriculum Budgets

The new approach is intentionally titled “BPA Affiliation/Curriculum Program”. BPA’s Workplace Skills Assessment Program, teacher/advisor professional development, career development resources, recognition, and leadership materials/resources are for advisors and BPA students exclusively and only available to registered chapters. Discuss the possibility with your administration or those responsible for approving curriculum expenses to see if there are curriculum dollars available to cover the BPA site license for your chapter.

State Funds

412 Program (Incentive) Funding is an allowable funding source to pay the BPA Affiliation/Curriculum Program Fee of \$400. Explore other options for the use of any state-wide grants or other sources of funds to assist with career development programs, CTE, student leadership development, and other college and career readiness initiatives. Even if your BPA program cannot be currently included in an existing grant budget, advocate for your program and make sure grant writers are including funding in budgets for your BPA program.

BPA Alumni

BPA has been in existence for over 50 years. They have benefitted from BPA and personally know the contribution it has made to their personal life and professional careers. Chances are there are BPA graduates from your school or that have moved to your community. They are ideal candidates to invest in the next generation of BPA students. Utilize social media like LinkedIn or presentations at the local Chamber of Commerce or other industry events to connect with alumni and build a partnership to contribute some or all of the BPA site license fee.

ADVANTAGES OF THE NEW STRUCTURE

There are many advantages of the new Affiliation/Curriculum Program including:

- Expand college and career readiness training within the context of business to more students than ever!
- Advisors no longer have to track down individual students for membership payments. Ease of compiling chapter membership and submitting online.
- Easy to budget and identify exact cost of BPA student participation for the chapter.
- More opportunities to attract funds from a variety of stakeholders to build a broad base of support (sponsorships, school funds, etc.) for a BPA program on campus.
- Increased Membership/Involvement
