

CPR/FIRST AID

HEAT EMERGENCY AND INFANT CPR

JUDGE/INSTRUCTOR INFORMATION

READ THE COMPETITOR SCENARIO (SITUATION) TO DETERMINE WHAT THE COMPETITORS KNOW PRIOR TO ENTERING THE ROOM.

THE TEAM HAS A TOTAL OF 12 MINUTES TO TREAT BOTH VICTIMS.

THE FIRST LIVE VICTIM IS A CONSCIOUS PERSON WHO IS SUFFERING FROM A HEAT EMERGENCY. THE SECOND VICTIM (INFANT MANIKIN) IS NOT RESPONSIVE OR BREATHING.

- DURING STEP 11C, JUDGE/Instructor STATES **“VICTIM IS CONSCIOUS”**
- DURING STEP 11D, **VICTIM HAS NO COMPLAINTS OF NAUSEA OR VOMITING**

BLS/CPR

- DURING STEP 18, SAY, **“EMS HAS ARRIVED AND TAKEN OVER CARE OF THE VICTIM.”**

SHOUT FOR RESCUER 1 TO ACTIVATE EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM AND GET AED.

* JUDGE STATES, ***“AED IS NOT AVAILABLE.”***

CHECKED TO SEE IF THE VICTIM IS BREATHING AND HAS PULSE

* JUDGE STATES, ***“NOT BREATHING NORMALLY AND NO PULSE.”***

- ***PROVIDE NO EXTRA ASSISTANCE TO THE COMPETITOR, HOWEVER, IF THE COMPETITOR LOOKS LIKE HE/SHE IS WAITING FOR YOU TO SAY SOME, SAY “CONTINUE” OR SOMETHING ELSE THAT ENCOURAGES THE COMPETITOR TO KEEP GOING.***
