Login credentials will be emailed directly to competitors by February 24. If the competitor does not have an email on file, the information will be sent to their local chapter advisor for distribution. Tests can be taken on a smartphone, tablet, or computer & are open book / open note.

Tests will be open for a 48-hour window. You can login to test anytime during this 48 hours. The same time limits will be used for testing, as explained in the original event guidelines (60 minutes, 90 minutes, or 120 minutes) with the exception of Medical Terminology and Dental Terminology.

Medical Terminology and Dental Terminology: The tests will be 45 minutes instead of 90 minutes.
