



HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

GCTC will adjust safety protocols based on the Oklahoma State Department of Health’s COVID-19 Alert System. It is designed to assess risk for COVID-19 exposure in counties across the state.

If Okmulgee County is in Orange or Red, the schedule will be adjusted **immediately**. We will move to the safety protocols for Yellow and Green only when Okmulgee County is there for three consecutive weeks.
